The Earlville Opera House Gallery cordially invites you to submit your students' artwork for our sixteenth annual **KidsArt** Exhibit, to be held from **February 27th- April 3rd, 2010**. This exhibit will feature work from students in Kindergarten through sixth grade.

Again this year, we are hosting our annual **KidsArt** Postcard Competition to select artwork for reproduction on our **KidsArt** Exhibit postcard invitations. Competition submissions are juried by a committee of professional artists and are included in the exhibit.





The EOH Gallery is a not-for-profit exhibit space and runs year-round exhibits of local, regional and national artwork. Our **KidsArt** Exhibit draws more than 500 people to our Gallery over the course of the show. The exhibit is a wonderful opportunity for children throughout the region to display their work in a professional gallery, and for the community at large to see the fine quality art these young people are producing.

We hope you will help us make this year's **KidsArt** Exhibit the most engaging show ever!

For the **KidsArt** Exhibit:

- You may submit up to 30 pieces of two-dimensional work and up to 5 pieces of three-dimensional work
- Two-dimensional work must be mounted on construction paper, as it is hung on the walls with masking tape, and we wish to avoid damaging the artwork
- Work must be **labeled** with the following information on the front for display:
 -  student-artist name
 -  grade level
 -  teacher name
 -  school name
- All work must be received at the EOH Gallery (address listed above) by **Friday, February 19th**

For the **KidsArt** Postcard Competition:

- You may submit up to 10 entries per school
- Digital entries are welcome, must be 300 dpi
- Maximum size for physical entry of a two-dimensional work is 8 1/2 x 11 inches
- Submit high-quality photographs for three-dimensional pieces
- Work must be **labeled** with the following information:
 -  student-artist name
 -  grade level
 -  teacher name
 -  school name
- All entries must be received at the EOH Gallery (address listed above) by **Tuesday, February 2nd. (Happy Groundhog Day!)**
