The EOH 1892 historic Landmark Theater has no ventilation system and the seats are close together. If you are ill, please stay home.


Masks are available on site for those who need/want them.

"Gallery in the Forest" project


In its third year, this event is about connections – student artists with professionals; arts with the natural environment; communities with each other.
