
"Gallery in the Forest" project








Come prepared to read from the show and sing a song that shows off your vocal strengths.



## "Crow Calls Twice"


Steph is an artist and researcher gathering moss in Leipzig, Germany. Through situated encounters and installations with material and temporal elements, such as textiles, objects,
