PURPOSE AND HISTORY OF THE DEC PROGRAM

The New York State Council on the Arts (the Council or NYSCA) is dedicated to preserving and expanding the rich and diverse cultural resources that are and will become the heritage of New York's citizens. In 1977, NYSCA developed the Decentralization program to ensure New York State's cultural funding reached every part of the State. This program is funded in all 62 counties, and funds are regranted at a local level. Through this program, not-for-profit organizations and individual artists may apply annually for grants up to \$5000 to help strengthen the arts and cultural programs in their communities. The goal is to make state arts support available to geographically, economically, and ethnically diverse segments of the state's population. The DEC Program has been administered in Chenango County since 1986 and Earlville Opera House has administered the DEC program since 2020.

GRANT CYCLE TIMELINE

- Grant Workshops - October/November 2020 - virtual
- Applications accepted October through January 15, 2021. NOTE: Technical assistance reviews end December 18. THIS IS A FIRM DATE.
- Panels meet to review applications February 2021
- EOH Board of Directors approves panel recommendations February 24, 2021

- Grant awards announced by March 2, 2021
- Contracts distributed March 2021
- 2021 Funded Projects MUST take place January 1 - December 31, 2021
- Grants Award Ceremony March 27, 2021 (pending receipt of NYSCA funds and/or State health guidelines)
- Final Reports due within 30 days of project end
